Re: *Selections from the Green Bay Art Colony* opens January 26 at Neville Public Museum

Green Bay, WI— *Selections from the Green Bay Art Colony*, an exhibit of seventeen artworks done by members of the Green Bay Art Colony, opens in the Neville Public Museum's Mezzanine on January 26 and continues through February 24, 2008. A preview of the exhibit and reception will be held from 5 to 7 PM on Friday, January 25.

This year's exhibition was juried by Donald P. Taylor, member of the art faculty and Curator of the art collections and galleries at St. Norbert College. Mr. Taylor selected artworks by Leah Abrahams, Kathleen Erbeck, Barb Halron, Mary Ann Huguet, Kathleen Jerlinga, Molly LeGreve Karjala, June Stube Kashnig, Rosella Kelly, Naomi Moes-Jenkins, Maggie Putin, Jo Watson, Tina White, and Roberta Van Lannen for the display.

The Green Bay Art Colony was organized in 1928. Prior to the formation of the Art Colony, a group of nine artists had been working together since 1915 as the Green Bay Art Club. The Club put together its first exhibition that same year in the basement of the former Green Bay Public Library. This served as the genesis of the Neville Public Museum.
