**Re:** Neville Public Museum trip to tour *Body Worlds* and Villa Terrace Decorative Arts Museum

Green Bay, WI—Join the Neville Public Museum for a tour of Milwaukee Public Museum's exhibit, *Body Worlds: The Anatomical Exhibition of Real Human Bodies* and Milwaukee's Villa Terrace Decorative Arts Museum on May 14, 2008.

The morning will be spent touring *Body Worlds*; a first-of-its-kind exhibit which uses the groundbreaking preservation process of Plastination—a process that replaces water in the body tissues with fluid plastics that harden, allowing the bodies to be fixed into lifelike poses to illustrate how our bodies respond internally to movements and everyday activities. Showcased are more than 200 real human specimens and more than 20 whole-body displays, allowing viewers to see inside the complex network of muscles, tendons and blood vessels that make up our bodies. Lunch will be served at the Milwaukee Public Museum, followed by a tour of Villa Terrace Decorative Arts Museum on the lakefront. The tour of Villa Terrace includes a guided tour of the house, their collections, and the beautifully landscaped grounds.

Cost of the trip is \$75 for members of the Friends of the Neville and \$100 for non-members. For those wishing to join the Friends of the Neville, total cost is \$105, which includes the \$75 ticket price plus a \$30 membership fee. Included in the cost is transportation, admission to the museums, and lunch.
