The activities are ongoing, so arrive between the times listed below and start the activity at your leisure. Costs vary depending upon day. Shaker Day

March 24, 10am – 4pm

Cost: \$2

Make a toy shaker out of laundry caps and beads. Takes 5-10 minutes.

Toy Top Day

Mar 25, 10am – 4pm

Cost: \$2

Make a toy top out of a CD and other fun plastic pieces. Takes 5-10 minutes.

Mosaic/Collage Day

Mar 26, 10am – 4pm

Cost: \$4

Make a collage or a mosaic out of matte board and magazine scraps. Takes 20-40 minutes.

Assemblage Art Day

Mar 27, 10am – 4pm

Cost: \$5

Make a toy, sculpture or fun piece of art. Takes 30-40 minutes.

Fairy Wand Craft

Mar 28, 10 am – 4 pm

Cost: \$5

Make a fairy wand with a star. Use lace, glitter and beads and trinkets.

The week will end with an Explorer Saturday on Sat Mar 29 from 11am-3pm. The theme is World War I and is held in conjunction with the exhibit *The Traitor State: Wisconsin in World War I*.
