Re: **The Neville Public Museum presents *Natural History Lecture Series, Baird Creek: The Hidden Jewel of Green Bay***

Green Bay, WI— The Neville Public Museum presents *Natural History Lecture Series, Baird Creek: The Hidden Jewel of Green Bay* on Wednesday, June 11, 2008. The presentation will begin at 7 pm at the Neville Public Museum and is free.

Baird Creek Park contains 17 distinctly different biological communities ranging from sedge meadows to oak-hickory upland forest. Portions of the park contain trees that began their life just after the Great Peshtigo Fire of 1871. The creek itself supports a diverse variety of fish ranging from redbreast dace to largemouth bass. The talk, presented by Steve Lambert of the Baird Creek Preservation Foundation, will focus on the flora and fauna of Baird Creek Park and the efforts of the Baird Creek Preservation Foundation to maintain the ecological integrity of the park.
