***The Artists of Studio 210: 2007* now on display at the Neville Public Museum**

Green Bay, WI—July 1, 2008—The artists who participated in the Neville Public Museum's *Studio 210: Working Regional Artists* program during 2007 are included in a small exhibit titled *The Artists of Studio 210: 2007*, which is now open in the Museum's Mezzanine and continues through August 24.

The five artists in the exhibit are Molly LeGreve Karjala, watercolor paintings; Tina Bechtel, basketry; Daniel Klewer, oil paintings; Marian Puckett, ceramics; and Judy Ribbens, mixed media.

The Museum inaugurated the *Studio 210* program in September 2005 to promote area artists in a studio setting. Each artist is in the program for a four-month period and is required to spend at least six hours per week in the studio.
