Visitors may ask questions, talk about art, or just watch you work. *Studio 210* artists also have the opportunity to show and sell examples of their work in the Neville Gift Shop

The Museum is now accepting applications from artists who would like to be considered for the months of January through April 2009. Up to three artists will be selected for these four months. Candidates who would like to be considered for this session must submit their completed applications by November 22, 2008.
