### **72<sup>nd</sup> Art Annual Juried Exhibition Opening at the Neville Public Museum**

Green Bay, WI---April 3, 2017---The 72<sup>nd</sup> Art Annual exhibit is an all media, juried exhibition of current artworks produced by artists living in the counties of Northeastern Wisconsin and Michigan's Upper Peninsula. A total of 47 artworks by [35 artists](#) were chosen by the juror, Helen Klebesadel. Klebesadel is an Artist and Director of Women's and Gender Studies Consortium at UW System.
