September 7: *Writing with Fire* (2021, India).

*Writing with Fire* tells the story of Khabar Lahariya, the only news agency in India run by Dalit (oppressed caste) women. Armed with smartphones, these women journalists report from some of the most difficult regions of the country, risking everything to speak truth to power.

October 5: *Chihuly over Venice* (2001, USA)

This documentary records a project by acclaimed glass artist Dale Chihuly to create spectacular chandeliers to hang over the canals of Venice. Shown in conjunction with the United Nations International Year of Glass.

November 2: *Syndrome X* (2021, Italy)

*Syndrome X* tells the true story of three Roman Catholic doctors who created a fictional highly contagious disease during the Holocaust as a pretense to hide Jews in a Vatican-affiliated hospital.

December 7: *Barking Water* (2009, USA)

Seminole Nation director Sterlin Harjo presents viewers with his own personal Oklahoma, which includes an eclectic mix of humanity. The film chronicles a road trip by a dying man and his former lover across the state to visit friends and his family in Wewoka, the capital of the Seminole Nation.
