Exhibit Opening: *The Artists of Studio 210: 2011*

Green Bay, WI—January 31, 2012— *The Artists of Studio 210: 2011*, an exhibition featuring local artwork, settles into the Neville February 11th through April 22, 2012.

Five artists who participated in the Neville Public Museum's *Studio 210: Working Regional Artists* program during the 2011 calendar year will be featured. Paintings and jewelry are included in the exhibition, as is a variety of subject matter.

The artists, each represented by three artworks, are: Maura Vazquez, Lawrence Jankowski, Meg Anderson, Sally Berner and Angie Neal.

The Museum inaugurated the Studio 210 program in September 2005 to promote and encourage area artists in a working studio setting. The Museum provides local and regional artists with studio space for a four-month period in exchange for working in the Studio for a minimum of six hours per week. Interaction between the artists and visitors is an important part of the program; visitors can watch the artists as they work on their projects and conversation is welcome. The program offers a wonderful opportunity for visitors to ask questions about art or the various materials being used, in addition to seeing first-hand how art is actually made.
