Border to Border: Brown County Photo Panels Installed at Brown County Organizations

This community wide outreach exhibit consisting of photographs from the *Press-Gazette Negative* Collection is made possible through funding from the Institute of Museum and Library Serivces (IMLS). This series of exhibits throughout Brown County is one part of a large project to catalog the approximately one-million images in the *Green Bay Press-Gazette* Collection of the Neville Public Museum of Brown County. Each panel is site-specific and includes unique images of the organization at which it's displayed.
