Ben's Wish Poster and Essay Contest from local schools will be displayed in the Neville classrooms July 3rd - 8th. The essay themes are "Hunger Awareness and What We Can Do." The posters illustrate Ben's Wish of people helping people within our own community. Students participating in this year's contest are from St. Thomas More, Jefferson and Beaumont Elementary, all of Green Bay, and Assumption B.V.M. of Pulaski. A combined effort of over 200 posters and essays will be on display. Top entries in each division were asked to be chosen by their schools, respectively. The 1st place winning essay and poster

entry were selected by the Ben's Wish committee. Ribbons will be awarded to all top entries with a "celebratory" fire truck ride to school this fall for the top essay and poster winner. Ben's Wish is a program which has provided food to the hungry in our community since July 4th, 2009.
