The foundation is a government recognized not-for-profit organization. It funds all museum exhibits and programs. Tax dollars are not used for exhibit and program costs. It does this through tax-deductible donations received from individuals, corporations, and businesses; grants from private and corporate foundations; grants from such agencies as the Wisconsin Arts Board and Wisconsin Humanities Council; bequests and planned giving; service organizations; memberships in the Friends of the Neville; and proceeds from its gift shop.

In addition to being the sole funding provider of all programming and exhibits, it underwrites all in-house and traveling exhibits. It also funds exhibit marketing, artifact purchase and conservation, gallery construction and installation materials. It also pays for printed educational gallery handouts and catalogs, audio-visual equipment, and computer hardware and software used in exhibits, exhibit-related programming and other educational activities.
