### **Calling all Presenters!**

Green Bay, WI—April 19, 2012—The Neville Public Museum is seeking vibrant community members to present speeches, demonstrations, or performances which engage audiences in subjects relating to Brown County and Northeast Wisconsin. Selected applicants will present on stage in the upcoming exhibit *Museum PLACE*, opening June 23, 2012.

Presentations can be formal or informal, but must relate to our community or activities in our community. Audience size will vary depending on the day and time of sign up, and presentations will take place hourly (during normal Museum hours) from June 23<sup>rd</sup> through the exhibit close in 2013. Presentation length may vary from as little as ten minutes to one hour. Presenters will select a specific day and time, and they may sign up for multiple sessions. If you are unable to present in person, we welcome you to submit a video. Videos will be shown on rotation while there are no live presentations.

Examples of presentations can include:

- A dance troupe that performs and discusses the cultural significance of the dance.
- A PowerPoint presentation about the environmental changes in the Fox River.
- A presentation on how to assemble an ice shanty.
- A discussion on tailgating etiquette, including preparation and teardown before the game.
- Natural history or historical presentations.
- Art and crafts demonstrations.

Potential presenters can include:

- State/county/city employees
- Non-profit agencies
- College/university professors
- Hobbyists
- Businesses (for topical, not sales content)

The Museum staff will receive applicants and then judge and select presenters based on three criteria:

- How participatory/engaging is the presentation?
- How much does it speak of the uniqueness of Northeast Wisconsin?
- How much will it support discussion or exchange of ideas about our community?
