***Waterwalk* movie dives into the Neville!**

Green Bay, WI—September 18, 2012— *Waterwalk*, a movie featuring an epic, thousand mile canoe journey on the Mississippi River, will be shown at the Neville Public Museum on Wednesday, September 26, 2012 at 6:30 p.m. This father/son bonding drama was heavily filmed in Wisconsin along the Fox, Wisconsin and Mississippi rivers.

Waterwalk is based on Steve Faulkner's story of his attempt to take the trip of a lifetime with his son, Justin, on one of the most difficult canoe routes in the American heartland. Braving rough water, big storms, flood Stage Rivers and portaging larger sections of the heavily dammed Fox, the Faulkners nearly run out of money, become minor celebrities and confront the ultimate challenge presented to fathers who leave their jobs to spend more time with their children: boredom. A journey through middle America, *Waterwalk* is a memorable look at an archetypal journey that defines our nation and informs the heart.

Waterwalk was not only filmed in Green Bay, but Oconto, Appleton, Neenah, Portage, Spring Green, Boscobel, Muscoda, Prairie du Chien, Milwaukee, Mequon, and Wauwatosa, and has been played to sellout audiences across the Midwest in cities like Detroit, Chicago and St. Louis since it's May release.

Robert Cicchini directed and stars in the film. He is known for his roles in *Godfather III*, *Dream Girls*, *The Mentalist*, *Law and Order*, and *Six Feet Under*.

Waterwalk is unrated, but considered PG.
