Neville Museum to have extended hours and admission deals during the Baylake Bank Tall Ship Festival

Green Bay, WI---August 12, 2013---The Neville Public Museum will have extended hours on August 16 and 17, 2013 during the Baylake Bank Tall Ship Festival. The museum will be open from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on those days.

There are also changes in price of admission during the festival. On August 16-18, the Neville Museum will be offering free admission for kids age 10 and under with a paid adult admission.

Normal museum hours, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. resume Sunday, August 18 and normal admission prices will be back in effect on Monday, August 19.

The Neville Museum will have a number of family-friendly maritime activities at the museum during the Tall Ship festival. Activities include origami and wallpaper sail crafts, tall ships puzzles, historic photos available for viewing in 3-D, and a special visit from The Great Lakes Fishery Commission who will have sea lampreys at the museum!

There will also be performances by the Heritage Players at the Neville Museum. They will perform *Waterways* at 1 p.m. and 3 p.m. on August 17 and 18 in the Neville Museum theater. Free with admission.
